How we use your data:

The Forum does not share members information and personal data to third parties

How we store your data:

All Membership details are held by the Northamptonshire Heritage Forum Committee and are securely held on an electronic database. They are not passed on to third parties without your written consent. Contact may be made with members by email, SMS or phone and by post.

If after three years you have made no contact with the Forum we will delete your information from the database.
